Program Overview for March 18, 2010 – Basics of OSHA Inspections

Employers and employees have rights and responsibilities under the OSHA Act that start when the OSHA compliance officer shows up on a work site and end with the resolution of any citations that have been issued. Awareness of inspection processes and procedures can make the entire process less intimidating. This session will focus on those very basic rights that both employers and employees have during and after OSHA inspections.
