From such time agreement between the parties is reached, Respondent shall have an additional 24 hour to abate and submit the agreed-upon amended abatement verification to OSHA before the tolling period terminates.</p> <p>Respondent may not submit Abatement Verification until abatement is complete.</p>		<p>OSHA may initiate a warrantless inspection 168 hours after the Section VIII OSHA Notice was transmitted to Respondent.</p>
