Executive Summary

OSHA's National Emphasis Program (NEP) for Falls, CPL 03-00-025, (effective date 05/01/2023), describes policies and procedures to identify and to reduce hazards which are causing or likely to cause serious injuries and fatalities from falls while working at heights. This national directive therefore removed the obligation for Regions to develop a local emphasis program addressing fall hazards.
