



Stay Safe at Maritime Facilities

As an employee, you may be exposed to numerous hazards at maritime facilities. To keep yourself and others safe, it is important to be aware of your surroundings.

Remember to:

- Wear the appropriate fitting clothing for the job. Loose clothing can get caught in equipment.
- Report unsafe conditions.
- Keep walkways clearly marked, well lit, and free of hazards.
- Watch for slip hazards such as water, ice, blast grit, and oil.
- Avoid walking through congested areas. Be aware of equipment nearby (e.g., cranes with suspended loads, forklifts, and other vehicles).
- Never cross over installed barriers, ropes, and cordoned-off areas.
- Don't walk while talking on the phone.
- Hold on to handrails when climbing stairs.
- Maintain three points of contact when using ladders.
- Focus on one task at a time.
